

Deniliquin High School

Works notification

10 October 2022

During construction in the school holidays, as part of the food tech upgrade at Deniliquin High School, asbestos containing material was found in the floor tiles in Block B.

The material was bonded asbestos, which means it was attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Work took place on Thursday 6 October and Friday 7 October 2022. All asbestos containing material was removed out of school hours and in accordance with the advice from the independent hygienist.

Safety measures and monitoring were in place and the area remained out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work was completed.

This area was remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area was inspected to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school received a clearance certificate, following remediation.
