

Hunter River High School

Works notification | 3 August 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are repairing a cracked water pipe at Hunter River High School, which involves removing a section of the concrete path to the east of Building A (Wellbeing block 1).

During this work, assumed asbestos-containing material, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan, may be removed from the grounds.

As a precaution, a metre section of the concrete path has been temporarily closed.

Work to remove this part of the concrete and replace the pipe underneath will be done outside of school hours on **Monday 3 August 2026**. Once this work is finished, the concrete path will be restored and access can resume.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work will be completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists with air monitoring in place.

Asbestos was used widely in Australian building materials before 1990. We manage the presence of asbestos in NSW public schools by maintaining an Asbestos Management Plan for each school and engaging independent hygienists for expert advice.
