

# Bass High School

## Works notification | 3 April 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

A cracked eave sheet was found by staff, attached to a demountable classroom next to Building K, at Bass High School during a routine inspection on 24 March 2025.

The eave sheet contains bonded asbestos and is listed in the school's asbestos register.

The area was fenced off made inaccessible to staff and students the same day (24 March).

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The sheet will be removed on Saturday 5 April by licenced asbestos contractors and work will be inspected by an independent hygienist.

Safety measures, including air monitoring will be in place while work is being done.

Work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan

The eave will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
