Works notification | 8 May 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are making improvements at Blakehurst High School by converting spaces in buildings B and D into new girls' toilet facilities.

Construction will start from **Saturday 16 May 2026**. From this date, demolition of the existing spaces will start and the following will be installed:

- temporary fencing to isolate the construction area
- partitions, floor covering, fixtures, fittings and finishes
- new water efficient amenities including toilets, basins and taps.

Construction vehicles will enter the site via Woniora Road and Foster Street and park in the school carpark.

Hours of work are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

There may be some low level noise during demolition activities. We are committed to minimising disruptions where possible and have coordinated this work with school leadership to avoid any interruption to lessons.

This project is expected to be finished by July 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.
