Dear staff, parents and carers

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Thursday 21 May 2026, the vinyl tiles in the movement area in Building D were accidentally damaged at Riverside Girls High School.

The vinyl tiles are known to contain bonded asbestos and are listed on the school's asbestos register. As a precaution, the area was isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials took place on the evening of Tuesday 26 May 2026. The area was reopened on the afternoon of Wednesday 27 May 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials took place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
