Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

During IT upgrades throughout Riverside Girls High School, the ceiling in the movement area, in front of the computer classroom entry in Building C was accidentally damaged on Tuesday 21 April 2026.

The ceiling is known to contain bonded asbestos and is listed on the school's asbestos register. The damaged ceiling was made safe by securing the damaged area with a plastic sheet.

As a precaution, the area has been isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will take place on Saturday 25 April 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
