Dear students, parents, carers and staff

During recent maintenance work at Riverside Girls High School, asbestos containing material was discovered in vinyl tiles in the staff kitchen. The door was locked and placed out of bounds.

Safety measures and air monitoring were put in place and the area remained out of bounds until the asbestos removal work was completed.

Work took place to remove and replace the vinyl tiles on Saturday 24 February 2024.

An independent hygienist inspected the area to confirm it has been fully remediated and issued a clearance certificate.

The room has been reopened and made available for use.

Work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.
