Works notification | 7 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are replacing the flooring in a storage room in Building K at Blacktown Boys High School.

The vinyl tiles under the carpet in this room are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register. The carpet and vinyl tiles are currently undisturbed.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work will take place on Saturday 24 and Sunday 25 May 2025 between 8 am and 4 pm. Access will be restricted during this time.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once work is finished, an independent hygienist will inspect the site and issue a clearance certificate. The room is expected to be reopened for use on Monday 26 May 2025.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
