Investing in our schools

The NSW Government's 2024-25 Budget includes a record investment in public education, with \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades to support growing communities.

As part of its commitment to high potential and gifted education (HPGE), the government is investing \$50 million in the HPGE Partner School program.

Project overview

Stage 1

Construction of Stage 1 upgrades at Matraville Sports High School are scheduled to begin in July 2025.

Stage 1 includes:

- resurfacing the quadrangle sports court, including new line marking
- improving access and amenities at the synthetic sports field.

Stage 1 is expected to be finished in August 2025.

Stage 2

A design consultant has been engaged to produce detailed designs for Stage 2. Stage 2 includes upgrades to the following:

- Block B's specialised classrooms for the Aboriginal Centre of Excellence
- food technology room and hospitality kitchen
- music room and art workshops
- general learning spaces
- Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) rooms
- woodwork rooms
- gymnasium and fitness laboratory.



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The detailed designs for Stage 2 are 80% complete. The tender process to appoint a construction contractor for Stage 2 is expected to be underway in August 2025.
