Matraville Sports High School Works notification | 13 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are replacing the damaged roof on Building G at Matraville Sports High School.

Roof works started on Saturday 8 March and are scheduled to be finished by Monday 21 April 2025, weather and site conditions permitting.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday in accordance with NSW Environment Protection Authority construction times.

Removal of asbestos material

Part of this work involves removing and replacing the eave linings known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

On Saturday 22 March 2025, licensed contractors will remove the eave linings between 7 am and 5 pm. Extended hours on this day will ensure all asbestos is removed in one day.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Once the eaves are removed, an independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate and work on the roof will continue.

The building will remain operational with the school hall being closed for only two days during the works.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
