

Matraville Sports High School

Works notification | 26 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We would like to provide an update on the remediation of asbestos at Matraville Sports High School.

As advised in our [notification issued on 27 March 2025](#), Building G has been visibly wrapped and is non-operational following the identification of asbestos on 22 March 2025.

An exclusion zone remains in place around the building using temporary fencing and signage. Air monitoring is currently in place and has consistently returned results below the minimum detectable limit. This means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. < 0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines. These results show that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in this area.

A Remediation Action Plan (RAP) is being developed by an independent hygienist to inform the long-term actions for Building G.

The next step in the development of the RAP is the inspection of ceiling cavities in other buildings on school grounds as recommended by the independent hygienist. This includes Buildings A, B, C, D, E, F, H and I.

This work will take place in the Winter School Holidays between Monday 7 July and Saturday 19 July 2025. Hours of work will be between 7 am and 5 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday.

Access to the school site will be limited during this period.

- There will be no access to the buildings listed above between Monday 7 July and Monday 14 July.
- Community groups with existing arrangements in place for Building D will only be able to access Building D on weekends.
- Building J and the sports oval will be available for use throughout the school holiday period.

Air monitoring will be in place in each building while work is being done and a clearance certificate will be issued by the independent hygienist before each building is reopened before the start of Term 3.

All work will be carried out in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.



Building G will remain encapsulated and non-operational throughout Term 3 while the RAP is being finalised. Activities that were scheduled for Building G will continue to be moved to other rooms as required. There will be no other operational impacts to the school.

Air monitoring will remain in place around Building G.
