Works notification | 29 April 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We wish to advise we are upgrading the existing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) security system at Bellingen High School. The purpose of these cameras is to monitor entry into the school premises and add a level of security for students and staff.

As part of this upgrade, 19 additional CCTV cameras will be installed in the following areas:

- 2 cameras to the north-west of the admin building
- 2 cameras to the south-west and south-east of the library building
- a camera to the west of the music building
- a camera on the wall in front of the dark room in the art building
- 3 cameras in multiple areas in the science building
 - a camera on each of the east, west and north walls of the first floor
- 3 cameras in multiple areas in the MPU hall building
 - two cameras at the front of MPU (northern side) on the ground floor
 - one camera located on the stairs at the first floor.
- 4 cameras in multiple areas in the General Learning Building
 - a camera on each of the south-west and north walls of the building
 - a camera in front of the staff study
 - a camera between general learning classrooms 7 and 8
- 3 cameras in multiple areas in the TAS building
 - a camera on each of the south, east and west walls of the building

This work is scheduled to start and finish in Term 2 2026. Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

As a precaution, the areas will be isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors while work is being done. Safety measures such as temporary fencing will be in place during the work.
