Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools.

This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Planned upgrades

Construction commenced on Monday, 10 February at Bonnyrigg High School to build a new, single-storey multi-purpose flexible learning lab and sports arena with a covered outdoor learning area (COLA). Works are expected to be complete by the end of Term 3.

The new facilities will provide opportunities for students to collaborate, participate in co-curricular and extra-curricular learning activities and support the growing student population and their future learning needs.

Features



Flexible learning lab with 4 airconditioned, re-configurable classroom spaces for a range of learning opportunities



Hard surface, covered multi-use sports arena including basketball, tennis and futsal courts



New staff kitchen and staff and student bathroom amenities



New pathways and landscaping



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Location

The new sporting facilities will be located north of the current basketball courts while the multipurpose flexible learning lab will be directly west of the sporting facilities.



Construction information

Contractors are accessing the school site via the Cabramatta Road entrance, and temporary fencing is in place to secure work areas. All works will be carried out safely and efficiently to minimise disruption on the school community.

Toilet block enhancements

Refurbishment of the Building B toilet block was completed in Term 1, providing enhanced facilities for students, including:

- new floor and wall tiles and fresh paint
- upgraded cisterns, toilets and troughs
- replacement cubicle partition walls and doors.

Canteen refurbishment and ground remediation

Planning is now underway to refurbish the school canteen.

A scope of work is being prepared and once finalised, the project will go to tender later this year.

In preparation for the upcoming work, remediation of the underground storm water system surrounding Building B was completed in January 2025.

Canteen works are expected to begin in the 2025-26 financial year.
