## Bonnyrigg High School Works Notification | 12 December 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Following the information provided in the <u>works notification distributed on 13 August</u> (see below), the removal of bonded asbestos from the subfloor areas, beneath Buildings A and C at Bonnyrigg High School, is scheduled to take place during the Summer School Holidays (from 6 January to 24 January 2024).

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours and be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures, including temporary fencing and air monitoring, will be in place while work is being done.

Work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The subfloor of Buildings A and C will be inspected by the independent hygienist and a clearance certificate will be issued to confirm the area has been fully remediated.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.

## Works notification 13 August 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

While preparing for facility upgrades at Bonnyrigg High School, as notified in <u>Community Update 28</u> June, a structural inspection underneath Building C found materials suspected to contain asbestos.

While the subfloor is not accessible to students or staff, the area was immediately locked and made out of bounds.

Testing by an independent hygienist on 6 August 2024 confirmed the presence of bonded asbestoscontaining materials.

The school's asbestos register will be updated to include these results.

NSW Health explains if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low-risk.

A remediation plan is being prepared for work to take place at the same time as the school's <u>facility</u> <u>upgrades</u>.

All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.
