Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

A project is underway to upgrade the gymnasium facilities at Cronulla High School by installing a covered outdoor learning area (COLA) for fitness activities.

The planning pathway for this project, the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) has been approved, allowing for construction to start.

Start of construction

Construction of the COLA is now underway and the following activities are expected:

- installation of an exclusion zone
- increased traffic movements
- increased noise and vibration

Construction vehicles will enter the school via Captain Cook Drive and park in the school carpark. Traffic control will be used as required for the safety of students, staff and the local community. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers when in place.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. We are committed to minimising disruptions where possible while work is taking place.
