## Ingleburn High School Works notification | 17 March 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

A demountable classroom, located opposite Building G at Ingleburn High School, will be removed from the school site in the coming weeks.

Due to the presence of bonded asbestos materials in its electrical hatches, as listed in the school's asbestos register, remediation work will be carried out in preparation for the removal.

The materials are currently undisturbed and in good condition.

Temporary fencing is in place to restrict access to the building.

Remediation work will take place on Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 March.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists, in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.


When work is complete, the classroom will be inspected by an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate to confirm it has been fully remediated.

We will keep the community updated with information regarding the demountable removal.
