Works notification | 19 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We would like to update you on the work to the Technology and Applied Studies rooms in Building C at J J Cahill Memorial High School.

Work has started and we expect the removal of all asbestos containing materials in Building C to be carried out on consecutive weekends throughout the month of March 2026, weather and site permitting.

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We are pleased to advise that high potential and gifted education (HPGE) upgrades are continuing at J J Cahill Memorial High School. Under the HPGE program, 33 high schools including J J Cahill Memorial High School will receive facility upgrades to accommodate increased enrolments and broaden educational opportunities. This is in addition to the tailored HPGE offerings available through the *Inspire* program at all NSW schools.

Upgrades to Technology and Applied Studies rooms

Following the project update issued December 2025, as part of the HPGE program, various facilities at J J Cahill Memorial High School are currently being upgraded.

As part of these works, material suspected to contain asbestos was discovered by workers in the floor coverings in Technology and Applied Studies classrooms within Building C. Work was stopped and the area was isolated. The area was already inaccessible to students and staff. This room was not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

An independent hygienist was engaged to test the material. Test results confirmed the material as bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All asbestos-containing material will be removed outside of school hours with access securely restricted, on Saturday 14 March, Sunday 15 March and Saturday 21 March 2026 between 7 am and 4 pm. An independent hygienist will oversee the work and conduct air monitoring. A clearance certificate will be provided before construction restarts.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws as well as the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. Thank you for your understanding and support during this important work.
