Works notification | 4 May 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

Further to the works notification issued in [March 2026](#), upgrade of the Technology and Applied Science classrooms in Building C has continued through Term 1 and the autumn school holidays.

As part of this work, material suspected to contain asbestos was discovered underneath a timber window frame on Monday 30 March 2026. Work immediately stopped and an independent hygienist was engaged to test the material. Results confirmed the material was bonded asbestos.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials took place during the autumn school holidays on Saturday 18 April 2026. An independent hygienist returned to inspect the work and issued a clearance certificate before construction activities resumed.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done.
