Works notification | 12 September 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

A staff member reported suspected mould in an office in the administration building on Tuesday 10 September 2024 at James Fallon High School.

An independent hygienist inspected the room, on the same day, and recommended it be locked as a precaution until testing and any remediation work could be completed.

Any affected staff members has been relocated to another office in the same building.

Use and access to the office will be restricted until the hygienist advises it can be reopened.

Woodwork storeroom update

The woodwork storeroom has been closed in Building N since 4 September, [as we notified you](#) on 6 September.

An independent hygienist found moisture in the ceiling void after carrying out an inspection and tests on 10 September.

The hygienist will provide remediation advice soon.

Safety measures and air monitoring will be in place if any work involving hazardous materials occurs.

All inspections and remediation works will be conducted in accordance with recommendations from the hygienist.

Use and access to the storeroom will be restricted until the hygienist advises it can be reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority.
