Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays

We will be working at your school during the Autumn School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 11 April up to Day 1 Term 2 (Wednesday 30 April).

On Tuesday 22 April and Wednesday 23 April we will be removing and replacing the flooring in 3 classrooms, a staff room, storeroom and the museum in Building F at Chester Hill High School.

The vinyl floor tiles in these rooms are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm in line with the Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the floor tiles are removed, an independent hygienist will inspect the rooms and issue a clearance certificate before the tiles are replaced with non hazardous materials.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
