## Remediation works completed over summer school holidays

The remediation work that took place over the summer school holidays at Lucas Heights Community School (notified on 12 December 2022) is complete.

All contaminated material, including asbestos, that was present below the surface of the school grounds has been removed and safely disposed of.

All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

An independent hygienist has inspected the area and a clearance certificate was issued to the school.

The area will continue to be cordoned off and remain out of bounds to allow landscaping works to be finished.

## Landscaping works on remediated areas underway

Over the summer school holidays, fresh natural turf was laid over the grass area to the east of the school's playing fields (see Area 1 on map).

Work to install artificial turf on the playing fields near Blocks A, D and M is underway (see Area 2 on map) and is expected to be finished for Term 2 2023.

Work to resurface the outdoor basketball court at Lucas Heights Community School has also resumed and the court is expected to be ready for use by mid-February 2023.

The future use of the grass area adjacent to New Illawarra Road (see Area 3 on map) will be determined by the school in consultation with our local School Infrastructure office. We will continue to keep the community updated.
