

# Georges River College Penshurst and Hurstville co-educational facility upgrade

## Project update | February 2025

Following extensive community consultation in Term 3 2022, it was determined that Georges River College, Penshurst Girls and Hurstville Boys Campuses would each become co-educational campuses from 2025.

We'd like to give you an update on the transition of the college as we become a fully co-educational setting from this year.

### **Project overview and progress update.**

We have delivered the following enhancements:

#### **Penshurst Campus**

- An upgrade of the play area to provide additional facilities for students was finished in October 2024.
- Conversion and refurbishment of the existing girls' toilets in Block B to create separate girls' and boys' toilets was delivered in October 2024.
- The installation of a new accessible bathroom and change room facilities in Block C was finished during the Summer School Holidays, in time for students to use from Day 1 Term 1 2025.

#### **Hurstville Campus**

- Conversion and refurbishment of the existing boys' toilets in Block II to create separate girls' and boys' toilets was finished in late 2024.
- Installation of new change rooms and toilets in Block D were delivered during the Summer School Holidays, in time for students to use from Day 1 Term 1 2025.

## New futsal court for Penshurst Campus

Separate to the work to transition the campuses to co-educational facilities, we have been working with Georges River College to deliver a new futsal court near the Penshurst Campus car park.

The new court was expected to be finished in time for students to enjoy from Day 1 Term 2025, however poor site conditions have delayed this.

Work on the new futsal court is continuing and is expected to be finished before the end of Term 1. There is no expected disturbance to student learning, however some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

The area will be temporarily closed to the public until the project is completed. Work hours are Monday to Friday between 7 am and 6 pm, and Saturdays between 8 am and 1 pm.

## Works at other Georges River College campuses

The following works were recently delivered at the Peakhurst and Oatley campuses of Georges River College:

### Peakhurst Campus

Construction of new change facilities in Block B were carried out during the recent Summer School Holidays. We also refurbished the existing girls' and boys' toilets in time for students to use from Day 1 Term 1 2025.

### Oatley Senior Campus

In late 2024 we refurbished an existing classroom in Block X. This included new carpet, operable wall, storage, lighting and reconfiguration of electrical and data points.
