

Kogarah High School Works notification | 15 December 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

A project is underway to replace the hall roof in Building 7 at Kogarah High School.

The main works for this project started in October 2025 and are expected to be finished on Monday 2 February 2026.

During this work, there may be an increase in traffic movements and noise during construction. We will make every effort to minimise disruption to the community where possible.

Traffic management measures are in place, as needed, for the safety of pedestrians and drivers while work is being carried out. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers.

Asbestos removal work

Part of this work involves removing the ceiling structure and lining which is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to remove asbestos was completed on Sunday 7 December 2025.

Safety measures including fencing, air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment were in place during this work. All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Work hours

Construction activities will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
