Kogarah High School Works notification | 30 January 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We would like to advise that we are undertaking works at Kogarah High School to facilitate community use of the sports field.

In order to improve safety and community access to the field, we will be replacing 3 sides of field fencing. We will also be installing 3 additional access points, including one access ramp and 2 new stair entrances.

Fencing and access works from 29 January

Removal of the existing fencing on Gladstone Street, Victor Street and Palmerston Street started on Wednesday 29 January 2025. This fencing will be replaced with a flat-top fence measuring 1.6 metres in height. Temporary fence panels will be installed in the short-term until the new fence panels are delivered. These fencing works are expected to be finished by the end of February 2025.

Construction of the new entry points to improve access will start on Friday 31 January. This work includes:

- installation of an access ramp and gate on the corner of Victor Street and Palmerston Street.
- construction of a set of stairs with an access gate on the corner of Gladstone Street and Victor Street.
- construction of another set of stairs with an access gate on Palmerston Street.

The entry point works are expected to be completed within 3 to 4 weeks.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

Work hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday until Wednesday 5 February during school holidays, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. From Thursday 6 February, when students return to school, work hours will only be carried out between 10 am and 2 pm to minimise disruption to school drop off and pick up times.

Traffic management measures may be in place for the safety of pedestrians and drivers while work is being carried out. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers.

There may be an increase in noise during this time. We will make every effort to minimise noise where possible. For more information on how we manage construction impacts, visit the School Infrastructure website <u>Managing construction impacts in your community (nsw.gov.au)</u>.
