### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

### Project overview

Planning is progressing for upgrades to bathrooms, air conditioning and electrical infrastructure at Pittwater High School. The project includes:

- installation of an additional 52 air conditioning units across the school
- separation of the existing toilet block into junior and senior sections, which includes:
  - upgrading the bathroom fittings
  - floor tiling
  - painting
  - electrical work upgrades
  - plumbing upgrades.

### Progress update

Separating the existing toilet block into junior and senior sections will take place in 2 stages, with the girls toilets proceeding first. Designs, which include changing the layout and entries of the toilet block, have been completed. Construction for the girls toilets is now in a selective tendering process, meaning it is open to selected candidates.

The air conditioning contract has been awarded, and installation will begin in March 2025.

### Next steps

In coming weeks, the tender for the girls toilets will be awarded, after which construction will begin.

When construction starts on the girls toilets, a selective tender for the boys toilets will be opened.



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
