

# Castle Hill High School

## Community notice | 2 February 2026

Dear parents and carers,

You may be aware that the department's handling of asbestos at Castle Hill High School between 20 April 2015 and 30 October 2018 has been investigated by SafeWork NSW.

The department has significantly improved its management of asbestos at Castle Hill High School and across NSW public schools since 2018. Regular inspections and air monitoring of the site are undertaken by the department and independent hygienists, including before any new construction or maintenance work begins.

In 2025, Castle Hill High School also completed a new School Asbestos Management Plan, which includes the [school's asbestos register](#), the asbestos incident management process and key points from the department's overarching updated [Asbestos Management Plan](#).

The department has now entered an enforceable undertaking (EU) with SafeWork NSW, which is an agreement to implement specific strategies to continue to improve asbestos management.

As part of the EU, the department has committed to creating a new Hazardous Material Management Digital Platform, developing additional related training and educational materials and sharing what we've done with other NSW government agencies.
