The school holidays are the ideal time for a lot of maintenance and project work to take place across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the Summer School Holidays

We will be doing work at your school during the Summer School Holidays. This period may include from the end of the school day on Friday 20 December 2024 up to the first day of Term 1, Friday 31 January 2025.

Works include:

- AV upgrade in the school hall
- window tinting, blind replacement and flyscreen replacement
- plumbing including leak remediation and gas line repairs
- carpentry including door replacements, window latch replacements and wall repairs
- electrical work including LED sign replacement, ceiling fan repairs and oven repairs
- tree maintenance, roof and gutter cleaning
- air conditioner servicing
- fume cupboard servicing
- roller door repairs
- carpet repairs
- pest control.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Each area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before it is reopened.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
