

# Castle Hill High School

## Works notification | 22 October 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

An internal wall within a demountable building at Castle Hill High School was damaged yesterday. Although the incident was not witnessed, staff later discovered a hole in the wall.

The affected area was immediately cordoned off, with restricted access secured on the same day. The hole was repaired overnight.

As a precaution, the demountable building will be inspected today by an independent hygienist using air monitoring to ensure asbestos-containing materials are not present. Once it is confirmed that the area can be reopened, usual school activities will resume.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and will be inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
