Works notification

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Upcoming planned maintenance works at Castle Hill High School will involve working with asbestos containing material located in vinyl floor tiles in Blocks A, E, and LL.

The material is bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to the vinyl tiles and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Safety measures and monitoring will be in place during the maintenance works. The area will be cordoned off before works start and will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is completed.

This area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Work will take place during the upcoming holidays between Monday 4 July and Wednesday 6 July 2022. All asbestos containing material will be removed in accordance with the advice of the independent occupational hygienist.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
