

Castle Hill High School

Works notification | 5 August 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We previously notified about demountable refurbishments at Castle Hill High School [on 28 May 2025](#). As part of this work, we are about to start the roof replacements on 5 demountable buildings – to proactively prevent leaks and improve durability.

Three of these demountables are located north of Building H, and 2 are located south of the sports oval. Each demountable will have temporary fencing and scaffolding in place during works. Any classes that are held in these rooms will be relocated to alternative spaces in the school.

The demountable eaves are suspected to contain bonded asbestos, as indicated in the school's asbestos register, and will be treated as such.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

On **Monday 18 August 2025**, the roof replacement work will start. It is expected that these works will be completed later in Term 3.

There will be air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment during the demountable works. Work hours are between 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 7 am to 5 pm weekends, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority and local council guidelines.

Any work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
