## School holiday works notification – Summer | 2025/2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

School holidays are the ideal time to undertake maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

### Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will be working at your school during the summer holidays.

This period may include from the end of the school day from Friday 19 December 2025 to Monday 26 January 2026.

Work includes encapsulating known asbestos-containing material (ACM) by adding new ceiling linings across buildings A, C, and D (locally known as Building D and E) at Nepean Creative and Performing Arts High School.

The ceiling voids in these buildings contain both bonded and friable ACM as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). Friable asbestos can be crumbled, pulverised or reduced to a powder by hand pressure.

### Update on the Remediation Action Plan

Since our last update in November 2024, ACM investigations, testing and ongoing air monitoring have continued across the school in line with the Remediation Action Plan (RAP).

All air monitoring to date across the site has returned results below the minimum detectable limit, which means it is consistent with acceptable levels in ambient air (i.e. <0.01 fibres/mL) as per SafeWork NSW guidelines.

These results represent a consistent finding that there is not a detectable level of asbestos fibres in the air in these buildings.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
