

# GyMEA Technology High School

## Works notification | 9 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Wednesday 25 February 2026, a hole was identified in the external eaves of Building B at GyMEA Technology High School.

As the external eave lining is known to contain bonded asbestos, access to the walkway between buildings B and D was immediately restricted with removal scheduled for Saturday 14 March 2026 between 8 am and 1 pm, weather and other conditions permitting.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be completed in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring will be in place while works are being done. All work will be done by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
