Works notification | 17 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of the department's proactive inspections, we have resealed known asbestos-containing material (ACM) in several rooms across buildings A, C, and E at Whitebridge High School.

The undisturbed material is located within the wall and ceiling panels in 4 classrooms in Building A, 4 classrooms in Building C and 1 classroom in Building E.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to reseat the ACM took place on **Saturday 14 February 2025**.

Safety measures were in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours and was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist with clearance provided.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
