Works notification | 11 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are refurbishing two staff toilets in Building B at Wingham High School. This work will involve working with asbestos containing material in the toilet partitions and window frames.

The toilets are being safely used at present as the partitions and window frames are undisturbed. They will be cordoned off before the work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place.

Work to remove the toilet partitions and window frames will take place on Tuesday 16 May 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The toilets will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the toilets are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
