## Canley Vale High School Works notification | 8 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Wednesday 9 April 2025, while cleaning a storeroom next to a woodwork room in Building B at Canley Vale High School, staff found broken vinyl tiles suspected of containing asbestos.

Material in the vinyl tiles in the woodwork room and storeroom are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

Access to the storeroom, the woodwork room and another storeroom connected to the classroom was immediately closed and remains out of bounds to students and staff.

We engaged an independent hygienist who will visit the site on Sunday 10 May to inspect and provide advice.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the remediation work is completed, an independent hygienist will inspect the work and issue a clearance certificate.

The 2 storerooms and woodwork room will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the rooms are reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
