

Miller Technology High School

Works notification | 20 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During scheduled maintenance works at Miller Technology High School on Tuesday 10 February 2026, a contractor identified broken wall lining panels in the classroom demountable, located across from the sport courts.

The wall linings are known to contain bonded asbestos as per the School's Asbestos Management Plan. Following this identification, an independent hygienist attended the site to undertake testing and provide recommendations the same day.

As a precaution and in line with the independent hygienist advice, the broken wall linings were sealed with adhesive and covered with protective plastic sheeting and the classroom was locked to students and staff.

An independent hygienist and contractor will be inspecting and remediating the classroom on Saturday 28 February 2026 between the hours of 8 am to 4 pm. All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists who will issue a clearance certificate before the room is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
