

Windsor High School

Works notification | 13 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are replacing windows in buildings L1, L2 and D at Windsor High School.

The putty material in these windows was suspected to contain bonded asbestos. Work was stopped and the areas were isolated. These locations are not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP); however, this part of the school was already inaccessible to students and staff, because the building was being renovated.

An independent hygienist inspected the area and collected samples. Test results confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will take place from Wednesday 13 May and be finished by Sunday 17 May. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
