

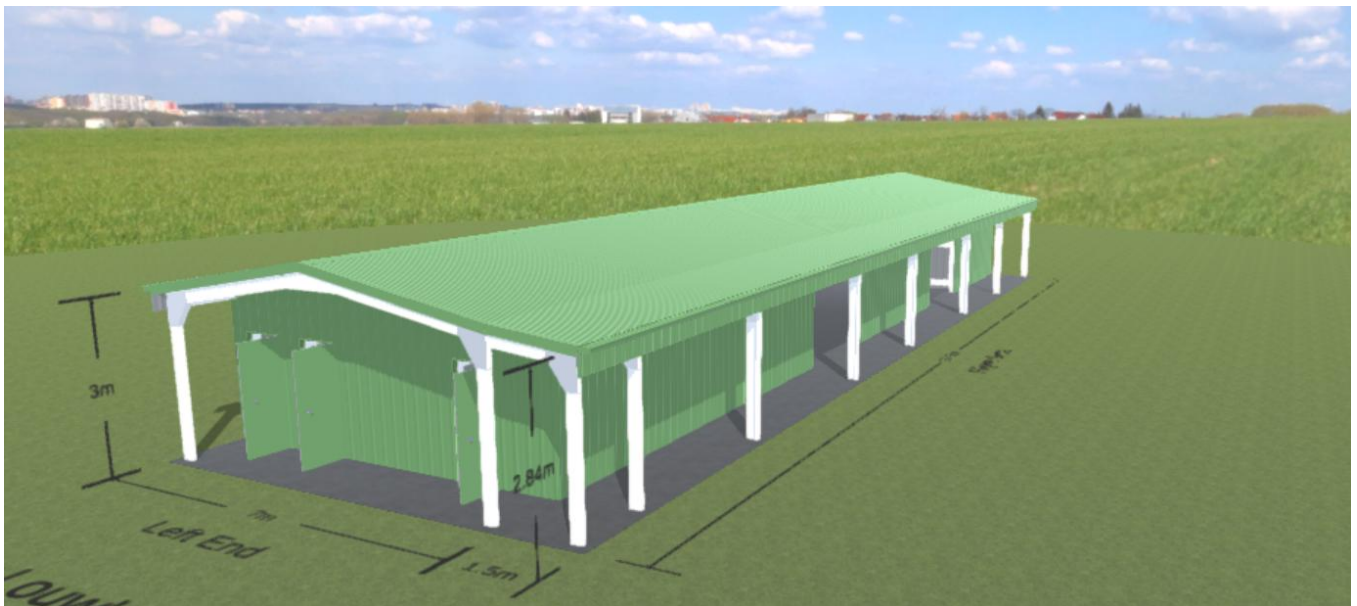
Windsor High School

Works notification | 24 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Works are underway to construct a new shed at Windsor High School to house its award-winning goats.

Located beside the oval next to Building AC, the new goat shed will accommodate the school's show goats and chickens, while also providing storage space and a small office with associated amenities.

What works will be undertaken at the school?

Due for completion mid-March 2026, all work on the new shed will be carried out between 7 am and 5 pm Monday to Friday and on Saturdays between the hours of 8 am and 1 pm, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

Site establishment is currently in progress, while fencing is put in place and sediment control is finalised. Works to excavate trenches and install concrete slabs will take place throughout December 2025 and January 2026.

The site will remain isolated from students and staff, and the oval will have fencing installed to prevent access. There will be no disruption to regular school activities, and all work will be carried out in accordance with work health and safety laws.
