

Doonside Technology High School

Works notification | 4 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Friday 30 January 2026 as part of planned works during summer school holidays, repairs were being undertaken to the flooring of the administration room in Building D at Doonside Technology High School.

The vinyl tiles underneath the carpet in Building D are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan. These vinyl tiles were removed on Saturday 31 January 2026. The area was already fenced off as part of the construction zone.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures, including temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment, took place while work was being done. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who provided a clearance certificate before the room was reopened for use.
