Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade the 5SPORTS facilities at Endeavour Sports High School. This project will deliver:

- resurfaced main playing field and 2 smaller fields to meet FIFA, NRL, AFL and World Rugby standards
- a new multi-sport indoor pavilion to enable inclusive all-weather participation
- upgraded clubhouse.

This project is being delivered by 5SPORTS in partnership with the NSW Office of Sport through the [Multi-Sport Community Facility Fund](#).

Progress summary

Further to our works notification from [5 December 2025](#), the project to resurface 3 playing fields to meet international sporting standards is now finished.

The 2 smaller fields located near the western boundary were finished in mid-2025. The full-size synthetic field was finished in February 2026.

Endeavour Sports High School students benefit from the use of these all-weather sports facilities, which supports the school's status as an Australian Olympic Pathway School. When not in use by the school, the Caringbah community and surrounding areas benefit from improved facilities.

Next steps

Planning for the new multi-sport indoor pavilion and upgraded clubhouse is currently underway. These works will take place near the 5SPORTS entrance on The Boulevard.

The new pavilion and upgraded clubhouse are expected to be finished mid-2026, subject to weather and site conditions.
