## Works notification | 30 January 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the works notification issued on 22 November 2024, we would like to provide an update on remediation of in-ground asbestos in the playground at Georges River College Peakhurst Campus.

Remediation works took place on the grassed area near Gate 1 from Monday 20 January to Friday 24 January between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm.

Temporary fencing was installed. Construction vehicles accessed the site via Samuel Street and parked inside the school.

All work was completed in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures including air monitoring were in place while work was undertaken, and all work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

### Previous notification issued 22 November 2024

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

On Tuesday 19 November 2024 during excavation for the installation of a new volleyball court, fragments of material suspected to contain asbestos were identified under the grassed area near Gate 1 at Georges River College, Peakhurst Campus.

At the time of the find, the area was already fenced off and inaccessible to students and staff as it is a construction zone.

An independent hygienist has been engaged to collect the fragments for testing, undertake air monitoring and provide remediation advice. Work has been suspended and the affected area has been covered in geofabric until clearance is provided by the independent hygienist.
