Dear parents/carers,

The NSW Government is investing \$60 million to provide roof repairs and replacements to priority schools across rural and regional NSW.

As part of this Roof Replacement Program, the Department of Education commissioned proactive investigations at Scone High School to identify potentially hazardous materials before work can begin.

Testing conducted by an independent hygienist has confirmed asbestos containing material and lead containing dust was found in the roof cavity of H. The roof cavity is inaccessible to students and staff.

Safety measures and monitoring have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community.

The material is scheduled to be remediated from the roof cavity on Saturday 29 and Sunday 30 May 2021.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff. We will keep you informed if further material is found which requires removal.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.
