

# Morisset High School

## Works notification | 20 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are repairing a damaged louvre vent in the hall building, south of the furniture storeroom, at Morisset High School this weekend.

The area is listed in the school asbestos management plan, so it was made out of bounds when the damaged vent was found.

An independent hygienist was engaged to undertake air monitoring, conduct a visual inspection and test a piece of the damaged vent.

Test results confirmed the vent contained bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The vent will be repaired Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 November, while no students are onsite.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists, who will provide clearance before the area is reopened for use.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
