Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

There is a large maintenance project underway at Ku-ring-gai High School, which includes roof replacements and classroom refurbishments.

Progress summary

We are excited to share that the roof replacements in buildings B and I comprising of classrooms and Technology and Applied Studies rooms at Ku-ring-gai High School are now finished.

These buildings now have an improved appearance and reduced chance of water leaks.

Next steps

Now that the roof replacement work is finished, planning will start from mid 2025 on:

- removal and replacement of vermiculite ceilings
- repainting of classrooms
- installation of new windows
- electrical upgrades including LED lights and fans in multiple buildings.
