

Evans High School

Works notification | 22 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Upcoming maintenance works to replace carpets at Evans High School will involve working with asbestos containing material in the vinyl tiles under the carpets in several locations including buildings:

- L (Library),
- AM (Administration),
- C1 (Art/Technological & Applied Studies),
- C2 (Technological & Applied Studies),
- HC (General Learning),
- S3 (Science),
- SC (Multi-Purpose Unit).

The rooms are being safely used at present as the vinyl tiles are undisturbed and under the carpet.

Work to remove the material will take place between Monday 3 April and Saturday 16 April 2023. All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

The affected rooms will be cordoned off before works start and will remain out of bounds until the removal and associated flooring maintenance work is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

Additional works at the school

Works to install new and efficient LED lighting at Evans High School as part of the LED Lighting Upgrade program are underway. Works started on Tuesday 14 March and are expected to be finished by Thursday 30 April 2023.

Work is taking place from 3 pm to 1 am on weekdays and from 7 am to 5 pm on Saturdays.
