Works notification | 18 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Exciting new upgrades to existing bathroom facilities and student learning spaces are planned for Turramurra High School.

In advance of these upgrades, bonded asbestos must be removed from rooms located in buildings A and E listed on the school's asbestos management plan. The areas will be cordoned off before the work starts and safety measures will be put in place. The removal will take place on Saturday 22 November 2025 outside of school hours, when no students are onsite.

An independent hygienist will be engaged to conduct air monitoring and testing following the removal of asbestos-containing materials. A clearance certificate will be provided before the area is reopened.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place in accordance with work health and safety laws as well as the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
