## Works notification | 6 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Due to a recent storm, we have removed and replaced water-damaged flooring in a senior study room, office and a common room in the Administration Building (Building A) at Francis Greenway High School.

The material in the vinyl tiles under the carpet in these areas contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Work to remove and replace the flooring took place during the recent school holidays on Friday 24 January 2025.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

Following the work, the area was inspected by the independent hygienist and clearance provided.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
