Works notification

Dear staff and parents/carers,

On Wednesday 9 November 2022 an external eave sheet detached from a demountable building which is currently being used as an art room. This sheet is suspected as being asbestos containing material. As a precaution, the area has been cordoned off to isolate the area from students, staff and school visitors.

We are following all the advice and protocols of the independent hygienist.

Testing was conducted by an independent hygienist on Thursday 10 November 2022 to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If necessary, this area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure the area has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is re-opened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
