Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are replacing flooring in a computer room in Building C at Warners Bay High School.

As part of this work, we are removing the vinyl tiles under the carpet in this room which contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Work to remove and replace the flooring is planned to take place on Saturday 1 March 2025.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by an independent hygienist.

Following the work, the room will be inspected by the independent hygienist and clearance provided.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
