Warners Bay High School Works notification | 2 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Wednesday 21 May 2025, following heavy rain which resulted in a water leak, we isolated a science preparation room in Building C (used as a general classroom block) at Warners Bay High School to replace water-damaged flooring.

The vinyl tiles in this room contain bonded asbestos. NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

This room will remain closed for students and staff until the flooring is replaced.

On Saturday 14 June 2025 we will be removing the existing vinyl tiles and conducting repairs.

During the tile removal works there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

Once the tiles have been removed and the flooring replaced, the independent hygienist will provide clearance to reopen the area for use.


All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.
